

Report from Greg Durrant – Speed and Traffic

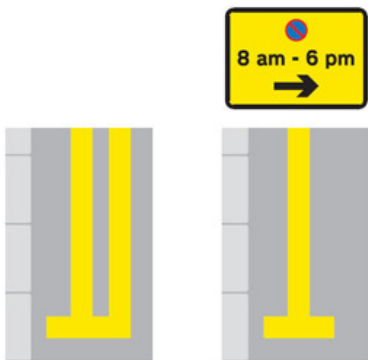


Speed and traffic through our tranquil village is always a concern, over the past few years BARS (Burwash Action for Road Safety) and the Parish Council have been campaigning and successfully reduced the speed limit in Burwash Common down to 50MPH.

With the latest spending cuts announced the pending speed and traffic review planned for Burwash Parish has been put on hold. This is where I ask for your help! If you live in the Parish please help us reduce the traffic speed through our village by sticking to the speed limits yourself. If we all do this it will only help to slow the traffic down.



We had hoped to get a safe place to cross for our village and alas this too may now be in jeopardy.



So again I ask for your help, we do have a number of parking restrictions in the village, some may say too many, but I am asking for all of us to help by being thoughtful about where we park. If you park outside the local shop or Post Office you obscure the view for those wishing to cross at that point. The bus stop is also used as a car park! Please be considerate and don't park too close to junctions which again can make it very difficult for other road

We will continue to liaise with East Sussex Highways to get the improvement we need to make our village safer.
